Father's Corner

"It is always better to give than to receive."

As my scripture professor, Father Obloy, passed out our blue books (books used to write in during an exam), he would say, "It is always better to give than to receive." There is a truth to it. During the Holy Season of Lent

we are encouraged to give alms for the poor. Catholic Answers explains that almsgiving is:

"any material favor done to assist the needy, and prompted by charity, is almsgiving. It is evident, then, that almsgiving implies much more than the transmission of some temporal commodity to the indigent... According to the creed of Christianity, almsgiving implies a material service rendered to the poor for Christ's sake."

Pope Saint Leo the Great preached that,

"There is no more profitable practice as a companion to holy and spiritual fasting than that of almsgiving. This embraces under the single name of mercy many excellent works of devotion, so that the good intentions of all the faithful may be of equal value, even where their means are not. The love that we owe both God and man is always free from any obstacle that would prevent us from having a good intention. The angels sang: Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth. The person who shows love and compassion to those in any kind of affliction is blessed, not only with the virtue of good will but also with the gift of peace.

The works of mercy are innumerable. Their very variety brings this advantage to those who are true Christians, that in the matter of almsgiving not only the rich and affluent but also those of average means and the poor are able to play their part. Those who are unequal in their capacity to give can be equal in the love within their hearts."

Another gem on almsgiving from our spiritual patrimony is from Saint Peter Chrysologus:

"Therefore, do not lose by saving, but gather in by scattering. Give to the poor, and you give to yourself. You will not be allowed to keep what you have refused to give to others."

Did you know? Did you know that Family Promise and the Catholic Outreach's House the Homeless Program have been recent recipients of the Shenandoah Valley Electric Cooperative (SVEC) "Operation Round Up" grants? Family Promise received \$2400 (including a matching grant) and Catholic Outreach received \$2500 plus an additional \$650 to provide fuel assistance to families in need. These grant moneys are made possible by SVEC customers opting to "round up" their electric bill each month. (Ex. A \$105.45 electric bill would round up to \$106.) This approximately \$6/year per customer creates the grant funds which then come right back into our Shenandoah County community.
