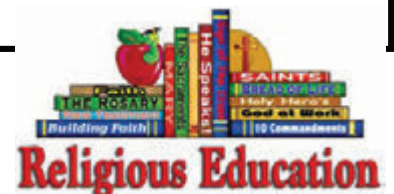

- ◆ For a child to receive their **Confirmation** they must attend 7th Grade and 8th Grade. This is a Diocesan mandate: a two year program.

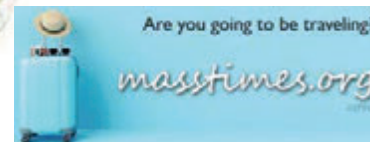
