## Father's Corner

The holy season of Lent is a powerful time during which we strive to draw ever closer to our Lord. I like to use the word strive because in a very real sense we are battling ourselves in our striving to be more conformed to our sweet Lord. Certainly, we do this throughout the year, but in Lent our striving is more acute.

We are in year A, which is my personal favorite for the Gospel readings of Lent. We hear in the Lenten Gospel passages that reveal so beautifully our Lord's love for sinners, the sick and the needy.

During Lent, in addition to penance and almsgiving, we also pray in so many beautiful ways: The Stations of the Cross, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the Holy Rosary, and the time spent in prayer before our Eucharistic Lord during adoration.

We also pray in our homes (the domestic Church), where many of you have a lit votive candle- beneath the Cross of our Lord and near an image of Our Lady. A parishioner recently asked me why we light votive candles? A great question and I found a great and concise explanation. Fr. William Saunders wrote in Straight Answers: "[We] light a candle before a statue or a sacred image of our Lord or of a saint...The light signifies our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition the saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord. The light also shows a special reverence and our desire to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart and go about our daily business." Please be assured of my prayers for you during this holy season.

Ciertamente, hacemos esto durante todo el año, pero en la Cuaresma nuestro esfuerzo es más agudo.

Estamos en el año A, que es mi favorito personal mente para las lecturas del Evangelio de la Cuaresma. Escuchamos en los pasajes del Evangelio cuaresmal que revelan tan bellamente el amor de nuestro Señor por los pecadores, los enfermos y los necesitados.

Durante la Cuaresma, además de la penitencia y la limosna, también rezamos de muchas maneras hermosas: las Estaciones de la Cruz, la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia, el Santo Rosario y el tiempo que pasamos en oración ante nuestro Señor Eucarístico durante la adoración.

La luz también muestra una reverencia especial y nuestro deseo de permanecer presente ante el Señor en oración a pesar de que podemos partir y seguir con nuestros asuntos diarios".

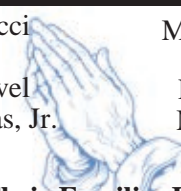
