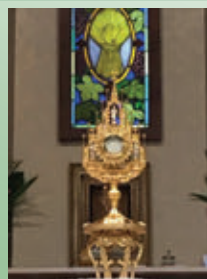

**NEW COVID GUIDELINES—more “Normalcy”**

Bishop Burbidge encourages all parishes to return to pre-COVID schedules for Masses, Adoration, and access to the Parish:

No occupancy limits on Mass attendance  
No social distancing  
No disinfecting or cleaning between Masses as expected during the pandemic  
**As for face coverings**

Fully vaccinated persons no longer need to wear a mask in any setting  
Unvaccinated persons are encouraged to wear face coverings  
The use of full Choirs may return to Mass

**The following liturgical elements that were suspended during the pandemic will return:**

Holy water, Procession, Collection, Offertory procession, and the sign of peace (without physical contact between non-family members)

The 5pm Vigil Mass for the homebound will continue to be livestreamed.

**Our Bishop is lifting the General Dispensation from the Obligation to attend Mass, and the obligation will be reinstated beginning the weekend of June 26-27, 2021. This obligation does not apply to those who are ill, believe they were recently exposed to any contagious illness, or confined to home, hospital, nursing facility. (Cf.
