Preparation for Christmas

Sunday, November 11, is the Memorial of Saint Martin of Tours. In times past this was the occasion for a Harvest Festival and Thanksgiving Feast. The day (this year, Monday, November 12) the spiritual preparation for the Great Feast of the Incarnation of our God would begin. It is (more or less) 40 days before Christmas and is called Saint Martin's Fast. It is marked (like Lent) by self-denial, prayer, and works of charity (both corporal and spiritual). Focused on the Lord, it is a time of yearning, of calm, of silence, of sorrow for our sins, and of hope and joy—how different from the world's approach. To make Christmas a Season (and not just a day) to be celebrated, we must prepare spiritually and effectively.
